

QUALIFIED ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE

A **qualified electronic signature** is the digital equivalent of a handwritten signature, carrying the same legal power as a signature on paper. It is a form of electronic signature that is fully recognized by Polish authorities, courts, and public administration.

It is issued by a certified provider and is based on a digital certificate assigned to a specific person.

WHEN DO YOU NEED A QUALIFIED SIGNATURE?

If you are a shareholder, a management board member, or represent a company in Poland, a qualified electronic signature is required to fulfill many legal and administrative obligations, such as:

- submitting changes and documents to the **KRS (National Court Register)**
- signing **financial statements**
- submitting the **CRBR (Central Register of Beneficial Owners) declaration**
- signing **powers of attorney for Polish institutions**
- submitting **TPR (transfer pricing) reports**
- signing commercial agreements, offers, and business documents
- upcoming **obligation for KSeF – National e-Invoicing System**

- Card with USB reader
